IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING YOUR REFUSE REMOVAL

Veolia Environmental Services (367-6040) is the refuse collection firm for the City of Oconomowoc. Collections are once a week on your regular garbage day. This service includes “up-the-driveway” collection. The collection is divided by the RR tracks – the **South side of the tracks is picked up on Tuesday, the North side on Wednesday and Hickory Woods is on Thursday.**

Weeks that include National Holidays on Monday thru Thursday (not Federal Holidays) have collections a day later.

Containers not exceeding 32 gallons and/or plastic bags not exceeding 60 lbs are the requirements of their contract with the City.

Recyclables need to be placed in the blue bin. Extra blue bins can be picked up at the City Hall (2nd floor) Mon-Fri 7:30am – 4:30pm on normal working days. The yard waste schedule is enclosed annually with your tax bill and can also be viewed on this website under the Dept. of Public Works.

The Household Hazardous Waste pick up in Oconomowoc is the 2nd Saturday in September 8:00am – noon. For other sites throughout the year, visit the Waukesha County website listed above.

White Goods: water heater, water softener, dishwasher, clothes washer & dryer, stove, refrigerator, microwave, dehumidifier, freezer, window air conditioner, and other similar items need to have a special pickup which includes a fee of \$15. Please call Veolia (367-6040) to make arrangements. Furniture can be placed curbside and there is no extra charge.
